Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for Prize Money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Clubs disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

Turn to the Classification and selective class or classes for which your dog is eligible, then complete the entry blank. Dogs under the age of 6 months on the day of the show cannot be entered. Please typewrite or print clearly on the entry form. The Club and the Show Secretary assume no liability for wrong or illegible information.

A recording fee of .50 cents and a \$3.00 Event Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show no refund of entry fee will be made.

Returned, Refused or Post-Dated Checks do not constitute valid entry fees and must be made good by cash or money order (including a collection fee) before the dog will be allowed to be exhibited.

No refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find duplicate entries will be made, however, if Entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on the Entry Blank. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Dogs that according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. **Novice Senior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.
